DAY 1 – ARRIVAL AT ALI-KETOLA FARM AT APPROX. 12:00 NOON

Accommodation and information about the farm, its surroundings, and the camp programme.

Lunch at Ali-Ketola.

Afternoon visit to a nearby reindeer farm. Fun games and enjoyable activities in the yard, including one exciting handicraft: building a birdhouse for forest birds. Dinner is served outside, enjoying the campfire at the same time.

DAY 2 – ACTIVITIES AND TRIP TO THE NATIONAL PARK

The programme for the second day includes forging in the forest, enjoying a motorboat ride, canoeing on the river, and traditional Finnish baking in the farm's kitchen.

In the afternoon, take a trip to the Puurijärvi-Isosuo national park, explore a Finnish forest and watch birds from a birdwatching tower. Walk along duckboards over a swamp area and have snacks by an open fire. During the summer, it's possible to pick herbs, berries and mushrooms, and prepare some delicious dishes.

DAY 3 – TRIP TO RAUMA

The third camp day will be spent in the city of Rauma. The aim of the trip is to get to know the rest of Satakunta region, and the area of Old Rauma in particular, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The trip to Old Rauma will consist of an English-language guided tour around the area, and shopping in the city centre at the end of the day. Snacks will be provided during the trip, but it is also possible to have lunch at extra cost. Dinner at Ali-Ketola farm after the trip. Free time in the evening, a fishing contest and smoke sauna.

DAY 4 – GET TO KNOW KOKEMÄKI AND TRIP TO YYTERI

During the school year (from August to May), visit Kokemäki secondary school and learn about the Finnish school system. Meet the local students, get to know their school culture and explore the facilities.

After school, visit a local horse stable. Possibility for some delightful pony riding. In the summer season (from May to August), take a trip to the city of Pori and Yyteri beach. Ropeway adventures or other outdoor activities in beautiful nature surroundings of Yyteri. The fun ropeways consist of different challenges and levels, climbing, sliding and balancing between the trees while crossing various obstacles.

DAY 5 – DEPARTURE

After breakfast, packing, farewells and check-out.
